Choose <u>two</u> of the following activities and have them ready to turn in on the first day of class. You must have a printed copy ready to turn in the first day and an electronic copy that will be uploaded to Turnitin.com during the first week of class. <u>BOTH the printed and electronic copies are required to receive</u> <u>credit.</u>

* Turnitin.com will check for plagiarism and AI usage. If plagiarism or AI is detected it will result in a failing grade and administrative consequences.

- You are a reporter. Write a front-page news story or a report based on a scene from the book.
- Write a one-page diary entry from the perspective of one main character from the book.
- Write a one-page review of the book. Your writing should be reflective.
- Write an advice column giving a main character from the book advice on how they should handle the problems/dilemmas in the book.
- Imagine you are the author of the book you just read. Suddenly the book becomes a best seller. Write a letter to a movie producer to convince them that the book should be made into a movie.
- Some characters are interesting, and you can relate to, while others possess a specific personality that is intriguing. Select a character that you either relate to or find intriguing and write a reflective page explaining your choice.
- Select a scene or line from the book you have read and explain why you believe this scene/line is so important and stands out to you.

All your responses must be:

- Well developed, use evidence from the text when appropriate
- Display understanding of the book
- At least one page long for each response
