Mandatory Uniform Policy

Students are required to be in uniform as of the first day of school!

Shirts

- Only Navy or Hunter Green Polos with School Seal, polos must be tucked in. Sold at Ibiley Uniforms.
- NO designer polos, NO T-SHIRTS.
- NO OTHER SHIRTS OR TOPS ARE PERMITTED.
- Fridays school spirit shirts are permitted.

Shoes

Closed shoes required;
 NO sandals, NO open heels,
 NO crocs or slip-ons.

NO HATS

NO HOODIES, NO bandanas, NO caps.

ID's

Wearing ID's will be mandatory.

Pants

- Only Khaki or Navy Dockers with a belt.
- · NO shorts of any length.
- NO JEANS, NO CAPRI PANTS, NO LEGGINS, NO JEGGINGS
- NO skirts or dresses of any length.
- NO pants with holes.

Sweaters

 SCHOOL APPROVED SWEATER only sold at Ibiley Uniforms.



 NO OTHER SWEATER IS PERMITTED unless it's SOLID Navy Blue or Gray.

Uniform/Dress Code Continued

- Students are expected to be in uniform on the first day of school
- Navy or hunter green polos
 - Polo shirt must have collar
 - ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR THE SCHOOL SEAL IN THE UPPER LEFT-HAND CORNER OF THEIR SCHOOL UNIFORM SHIRT
- Khaki or Navy Colored Pants
- Closed toes shoes with a back (no crocs)
- □ ATHLETICS & ACTIVITIES HOODIES ONLY ALLOWED WITH HOOD DOWN!! NO OTHER HOODIES ALLOWED!!
- Sweaters allowed
 - School sponsored athletic or activities hoodies ONLY
 - Navy Blue or Forest Green sweaters are permitted (SOLID COLORS WITH NO DESIGNS OR LOGOS)
 - Sweaters with logos, brand-names, or designs are NOT ALLOWED!


- How can I see my counselor?

Minimum of 60 hours to graduate10 months X 1.5 hours per month = 15 hours in one year

15 hours X 4 years = 60 hours


This is a requirement to walk graduation!

Community Service for Scholarships:

- □ Minimum of 100+ hours to receive scholarships and monies
- □ You are competing against others who have 100s of hours.

10 months X 2.5 hours per month = 25 hours in 1 year 25 hours X 4 years = 100 hours


